- The Short Films can be based on any subject or concept.
- Participants under the legal age, of 18 years at the time of submission, must submit a consent letter from their parent or guardian.
- Participants will retain all ownership rights to their films submitted, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan will not hold any rights of any submitted films.
- Multiple entries from the same participant are not accepted. It will directly lead to disqualification of both all entries.
- Censor Certificate is not mandatory for the film Submission.
- All content used in the short film must be either owned or licensed. If any copyrighted material is used in the film, the participant must have the permission and submit a copy to the Organisers.
